REASSIGNMENT OF HEADQUARTERS AND HEADQUARTERS COMPANY, 18TH MEDICAL COMMAND FROM THE UNITED STATES ARMY MEDICAL COMMAND TO THE UNITED STATES ARMY PACIFIC COMMAND

- 1. Effective 16 September 2020, Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 18th Medical Command (Deployment Support) (MCDS) (UIC: WNF4AA), a subordinate element of the United States Army Medical Command (UIC: W3VYAA), is reassigned as a subordinate element of the United States Army Pacific Command (USARPAC) (UIC: WJMZAA).
- 2. The Commanding General, USARPAC will exercise all authority, direction, and control over the 18th MCDS, to include prescribing 18th MCDS missions, functions, and responsibilities. The Commanding General, 18th MCDS will report to the Commanding General, USARPAC. All personnel, equipment, and other resources assigned or allocated to the 18th MCDS and its components are transferred and reassigned under the authority, direction, and control of the Commanding General, USARPAC.
