REASSIGNMENT OF THE CIVILIAN PERSONNEL EVALUATION AND ANALYSIS OFFICE

- 1. Effective immediately, the Civilian Personnel Evaluation and Analysis Office (DUIC W0ZZ10), a subordinate unit under the control and supervision of the Deputy Chief of Staff, G-1, Assistant G-1 for Civilian Personnel, is reassigned as a subordinate unit under the control and supervision of the Assistant Secretary of the Army (Manpower and Reserve Affairs), Deputy Assistant Secretary of the Army for Civilian Personnel (DUIC W00S10).
- 2. The mission of the Civilian Personnel Evaluation and Analysis Office is to conduct Armywide strategic assessments of civilian human resources program management by using evaluations, quantitative analysis, surveys, and special reviews. The purpose of these assessments is to meet oversight responsibility by assessing program effectiveness, efficiency, and compliance against the established standards. These actions are carried out Armywide both in the continental United States and outside the continental United States.
