REDESIGNATION OF FIELD OPERATING AGENCIES OF THE OFFICE OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT

The Administrative Assistant to the Secretary of the Army (Title 10, U.S. Code, section 3018) (UIC: W1YSAA), the senior career civilian within the Department of the Army (DA), is a principal advisor to the Secretary and has oversight of the administration and management functions within Headquarters, Department of the Army (HQDA). The Office of the Administrative Assistant (OAA) controls the following field operating agencies:


a. Effective 1 October 2022, the United States Army Headquarters Services Agency (UIC: W313AA) is redesignated as the United States Army Enterprise Services Agency (ESA) (UIC: W313AA) and remains under the control of the Administrative Assistant. ESA includes the following directorates:

Army Declassification Directorate
Army Publishing Directorate
Army Records Management Directorate

b. Effective 1 October 2022, the United States Army Resources and Programs Agency (UIC: W2TZAA) is redesignated as the United States Army Headquarters Support Agency (HSA) (UIC: W2TZAA) and remains under the control of the Administrative Assistant. HSA includes the following directorates:
