GENERAL COURT-MARTIAL CONVENING AUTHORITIES

- 1. The commanding officers of the following organizations are designated or redesignated pursuant to Article 22(a)(8), Uniform Code of Military Justice (UCMJ), as general court-martial convening authorities, effective the dates indicated. This authority will transfer to the commanding officer of any successor organization or command.
- a. United States Army Cadet Command, effective 20 September 2022.
- b. Fort Knox, effective 5 October 2022 (as a successor in command to the general court-martial convening authority designation granted to the Commander, United States Army Cadet Command and Fort Knox, Kentucky, by Headquarters, Department of the Army (HQDA) General Orders 2017-15, dated 24 May 2017).
- **2.** The general court-martial convening authorities of the following organizations are withdrawn pursuant to Article 22(a)(8), UCMJ, effective the dates indicated.
- a. United States Army Garrison, Okinawa, effective 30 September 2022 (HQDA General Orders 1981-03, dated 19 January 1981, is hereby rescinded in so much as it pertains to the United States Army Garrison, Okinawa or any successor organization or command).
- b. 10th Area Support Command, effective 30 September 2022 (HQDA General Orders 2002-16, dated 20 December 2002, is hereby rescinded in so much as it pertains to the 10th Area Support Command or any successor organization or command).
