



**REDESIGNATION OF INSTALLATION AND GENERAL COURT-MARTIAL
CONVENING AUTHORITY—FORT BRAGG TO FORT LIBERTY**

1. Effective 2 June 2023, Fort Bragg (Installation Code: 37225) is redesignated as Fort Liberty in accordance with Section 370 of the William M. (Mac) Thornberry National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2021.
2. Effective 2 June 2023, pursuant to Article 22(a)(8), Uniform Code of Military Justice, the Commander, Fort Liberty, is redesignated as a general court-martial convening authority (GCMCA) as the successor in command to the GCMCA designations granted to the Commander, Fort Bragg, by Headquarters, Department of the Army (HQDA) General Orders 1981–10, dated 9 April 1981, and the Commander, XVIII Airborne Corps and Fort Bragg, by HQDA General Orders 1981–3, dated 19 January 1981. This authority will transfer to the commander of any successor organization or command.
3. **United States Army Parachute Team.** Effective 2 June 2023, the United States Army Parachute Team (Golden Knights, UIC: W027AA) will be located at Fort Liberty. The United States Army Recruiting Command is responsible for the administration of military justice and administrative legal actions; however, the Golden Knights are attached to United States Army Garrison Fort Liberty for the exercise of special and general court-martial jurisdiction in the disposition of court-martial charges. The mission of the Golden Knights is unchanged.
