

**AMENDMENT TO HEADQUARTERS, DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY GENERAL
ORDERS 2018–10 (ESTABLISHMENT OF UNITED STATES ARMY FUTURES COMMAND)**

Effective 3 May 2022, Headquarters, Department of the Army General Orders 2018–10, dated 4 June 2018, is amended by removing the following language:

- a.* Paragraph 1b—“AFC leads the Army’s future force modernization enterprise.”
- b.* Paragraph 1b—“AFC postures the Army for the future by setting strategic direction, integrating the Army’s future force modernization enterprise, aligning resources to priorities, and maintaining accountability for modernization solutions.”
- c.* Paragraph 1c—“The Commanding General, AFC, will coordinate with the Assistant Secretary of the Army (Acquisition, Logistics and Technology) on all matters pertaining to research, development, and acquisition.”
