(U) PURPOSE: THE PURPOSE OF THE U.S. ARMY AWARD FOR PETROLEUM EXCELLENCE IS TO ENHANCE PETROLEUM READINESS AND STAFF OPERATIONS EFFECTIVENESS BY IDENTIFYING AND RECOGNIZING EXCELLENCE IN PETROLEUM MANAGEMENT AND FUEL HANDLING WITHIN THE U.S. ARMY.
