- 2. (U) THE PURPOSE OF THIS MESSAGE IS TO PROVIDE AN UPDATE FOR WEARING OF THE NAMEPLATE ON THE ARMY GREEN SERVICE UNIFORM (AGSU).
- 3. (U) GUIDANCE CONTAINED IN THIS MESSAGE IS EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY. SOLDIERS ARE NOW AUTHORIZED TO WEAR THE PRESCRIBED NAMEPLATE ON THE AGSU, WHICH IS AVAILABLE FOR PURCHASE THROUGH VARIOUS MERCHANTS. MANDATORY POSSESSION DATE AND ISSUE AT CENTRAL INITIAL ISSUE POINTS WILL BE 1 OCTOBER 2023.
- 4. (U) THE AGSU NAMEPLATE IS A LAMINATED PLASTIC PLATE, DARK BROWN TOP WITH TAUPE LETTERING, MATTE FINISH, AND WITH A BEVELED EDGE. ONE INCH BY THREE INCHES, WITH A TAUPE BORDER. LETTERING IS BLOCK TYPE, INDENTED TAUPE LETTERING, 3/8 INCH IN HEIGHT, AND CENTERED ON THE PLATE. ONLY LAST NAMES ARE AUTHORIZED ON THE NAMEPLATE. THE BLACK AND WHITE NAMEPLATE IS NOT AUTHORIZED ON THE AGSU AND ITS VARIATIONS.
- 5. (U) BEGINNING 1 OCTOBER 2023, THE NAMEPLATE IS REQUIRED TO BE WORN ON THE AGSU COAT, THE AGSU SHORT AND LONG SLEEVED SHIRTS, THE EISENHOWER JACKET, AND THE HERITAGE 564 PULLOVER.
- 6. (U) THE FOLLOWING WEAR GUIDANCE WILL BE INCLUDED IN THE NEXT REVISION OF DA PAM 670–1 (SEE ATTACHMENT 1):
- 6.A. (U) FOR MALE PERSONNEL, ON THE AGSU SHIRT AND ON THE AGSU COAT, THE NAMEPLATE IS WORN CENTERED LEFT TO RIGHT ON THE FLAP OF THE

WEARERS RIGHT BREAST POCKET AND CENTERED BETWEEN THE TOP OF THE BUTTON AND THE TOP OF THE POCKET.

- 6.B. (U) FOR FEMALE PERSONNEL, ON THE AGSU COAT, THE NAMEPLATE IS WORN CENTERED LEFT TO RIGHT ON THE FLAP OF THE WEARERS RIGHT BREAST POCKET AND CENTERED BETWEEN THE TOP OF THE BUTTON AND THE TOP OF THE POCKET. ON THE AGSU CLASS B SHIRT, THE NAMEPLATE IS WORN IN A COMPARABLE POSITION AS IN THE ARMY SERVICE UNIFORM CLASS B SHIRTS. PERSONNEL MAY ADJUST THE PLACEMENT OF THE NAMEPLATE AND DISTINCTIVE UNIT INSIGNIA OR REGIMENTAL DISTINCTIVE INSIGNIA UP OR DOWN TO ADJUST TO BODY COMPOSITION.
- 6.C. (U) THE NAMEPLATE WILL NOT BE WORN ON THE AGSU LEATHER JACKET NOR THE AGSU WINDBREAKER.
- 6.D. (U) THE NAMEPLATE WILL BE WORN ON THE HERITAGE 564 PULLOVER SWEATER IN THE SAME MANNER AS THE BLACK PULLOVER SWEATER.
- 7. (U) DEPUTY CHIEF OF STAFF (DCS), G-1 IS THE PROPONENT OF WEAR AND APPEARANCE OF ARMY UNIFORMS AND INSIGNIA POLICY.

Purpose

- □ These slides accompany the ALARACT on the addition of the nameplate for the AGSU. This is not Policy, just a general overview/guide to the addition. Please refer to ALARACT for specific guidance and utilize DA PAM 670-1 (26 JAN 2021) for specifics on authorized items and composition of the uniform.
- ☐ The information provided helps to inform and display examples of the recent updates to the Army Green Service Uniform.

Appearance of Army Uniforms

☐ The ALARACT serves as the standard until the next update of AR and DA PAM 670-1.

AR and DA PAM 670-1 dated 26 January 2021 currently does not authorize a nameplate to be worn with the AGSU.



Nameplate Information

Soldiers are now authorized to wear the prescribed nameplate. The AGSU nameplate is a laminated plastic plate, dark brown top with taupe lettering, matte finish, with a beveled edge. One inch by three inches, with a taupe border. Lettering is block type, indented taupe lettering, 3/8 inch in height, and centered on the plate. Only last names are authorized on the nameplate. The black and white nameplate is not authorized on the AGSU and its variations.





Nameplate placement on Male AGSU Items

**Male personnel. On the AGSU shirt and on the AGSU coat, the nameplate is worn centered left to right on the flap of the wearers right breast pocket and centered between the top of the button and the top of the pocket









Nameplate placement on Female AGSU Items

**Female personnel. On the AGSU coat, the nameplate is worn centered left to right on the flap of the wearers right breast pocket and centered between the top of the button and the top of the pocket.

**On the AGSU Class B shirt, the nameplate is worn in a comparable position. Personnel may adjust the placement of the nameplate and DUI or RDI up or down to adjust to body configuration.









Optional Clothing Items

** The nameplate will be worn on the AGSU Pullover Sweater and the AGSU Eisenhower Jacket.

**The Nameplate will NOT be worn on the AGSU Windbreaker or the AGSU Leather Jacket.
