- 2. (U) PURPOSE: THE U.S. ARMY AERIAL DELIVERY AND FIELD SERVICES DEPARTMENT AND THE ARMY SENIOR AIRDROP ADVISOR RELEASES THE ADRST FISCAL YEAR 2025 (FY25) INSPECTION SCHEDULE, IN COORDINATION WITH AND APPROVED BY HEADQUARTERS, DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY (HQDA), G-44S.
- 3. (U) APPLICABILITY: THIS INSPECTION SCHEDULE BECOMES EFFECTIVE FY25. IT APPLIES TO THE REGULAR ARMY, ARMY NATIONAL GUARD (ARNG)/ARMY NATIONAL GUARD OF THE UNITED STATES, AND THE U.S. ARMY RESERVE.
- 4. (U) INSPECTIONS: THE ADRST INSPECTIONS/AUDITS ARE CRUCIAL TO THE DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY (DA)'S ORGANIZATIONAL INSPECTION PROGRAM (OIP). THESE AUDITS ARE A VITAL TOOL FOR ENSURING THE COMBAT READINESS OF OPERATIONAL UNITS THROUGH THE ACHIEVEMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF REGULATORY COMPLIANCE. INSPECTIONS PROVIDE COMMANDERS WITH AN UNBIASED ASSESSMENT OF THEIR FORMATIONS READINESS AND ENABLE THEM TO ALLOCATE RESOURCES ACCORDINGLY. ALL COMMANDERS WITHIN THE DA MUST DESIGN AN OIP TAILORED EXPLICITLY TO THEIR UNITS' MISSION REQUIREMENTS. THE COMMAND AND STAFF INSPECTIONS ARE ESSENTIAL COMPONENTS OF THE OIP. FURTHERMORE, EACH UNIT MUST CONDUCT SIMILAR INSPECTIONS AT THE

BATTALION, COMPANY, AND DETACHMENT LEVELS. COMMANDERS MUST TAKE AN ACTIVE ROLE IN THE PROGRAM TO GUARANTEE THE IMPLEMENTATION OF QUALITY CONTROL AND EFFECTIVE MANAGEMENT CONTROL PROCEDURES.

- 5. (U) ALL INSPECTIONS CARRIED OUT BY ADRST WILL COMPLY WITH AR 1–201 AND THE ARMY'S INSPECTION PRINCIPLES. ALL INSPECTIONS AND STAFF ASSISTANCE VISITS WITHIN DA UNITS AIM TO EDUCATE, TRAIN, AND MENTOR. THESE INSPECTIONS AND VISITS ARE CONDUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH ADP 7–0, AND EFFORTS ARE MADE TO CONSOLIDATE THEM SO THAT THE SAME UNIT IS NOT INSPECTED MULTIPLE TIMES. ADRST AIMS TO ASSIST COMMANDERS IN ADDRESSING ENTERPRISE-LEVEL ISSUES SPANNING THE DOCTRINE, ORGANIZATION, TRAINING, MATERIEL, LEADERSHIP AND EDUCATION, PERSONNEL, FACILITIES, AND POLICY SPECTRUM.
- 6. (U) INSPECTION SCHEDULE: THE FY25 SCHEDULE BELOW GIVES THE PROJECTED MONTHS UNITS WILL BE INSPECTED. COORDINATION BETWEEN THE ADRST AND INSPECTED UNIT WILL SOLIDIFY ACTUAL INSPECTION DATES.
