**I..GENERAL COURTS MARTIAL.**—By direction of the President, the commanding officer, Headquarters Command, United States Air Force, is empowered, pursuant to the eighth article of war, to appoint general courts martial, *effective as of 27 May 1948.*

**II..GENERAL COURTS MARTIAL.**—By direction of the President, the commanding officer of each of the following is empowered, pursuant to the eighth article of war, to appoint general courts martial, *effective as of 1 June 1948:*

Military Air Transport Service.

Atlantic Division, Military Air Transport Service.

Newfoundland Base Command, Military Air Transport Service.

540th Air Transport Wing, Military Air Transport Service.

530th Air Transport Wing, Military Air Transport Service.

Bermuda Base Command, Military Air Transport Service.

Azores Air Transport Station, Military Air Transport Service.

**III..ROTC UNIT.**—*Effective at the end of the current academic year, on/or about 22 May 1948, the junior division ROTC unit at Pearl River Junior College, Poplarville, Mississippi, was inactivated.*

**IV..SIGNAL CORPS PROCUREMENT AGENCY.**—1. *Effective as of 15 May 1948, the following class II activities under the control of the Chief Signal Officer are redesignated as follows:*

a. The Signal Corps Procurement District, 2800 South 20th Street, Philadelphia 45, Pennsylvania, is redesignated the Signal Corps Procurement Agency.

b. The Signal Corps Procurement District, Chicago Office, 158 West Harrison Street, Chicago, Illinois, is redesignated the Signal Corps Procurement Agency, Chicago Office.

2. Section X, General Orders 68, War Department, 1946, is rescinded.
