GENERAL ORDERS No. 44

DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY WASHINGTON 25, D. C., 21 June 1948

- 1. In order to differentiate between the two Assistant Secretaries of the Army so as to promote efficiency, to avoid confusion and to facilitate handling and routing of correspondence—
- a. The Assistant Secretary of the Army who is responsible for the establishment of policies for, direction and supervision of activities concerned with procurement, industrial and related matters, including industrial mobilization and demobilization, and research and development, as delineated in AR 5-5, 15 March 1948, will be referred to as The Assistant Secretary of the Army; and
- b. The Assistant Secretary of the Army whose duties relate to the occupied areas will be referred to as Assistant Secretary of the Army.
- 2. The above distinction will be employed in addressing correspondence to, and the preparation of correspondence for, the Assistant Secretaries, and their offices will be referred to respectively as follows:
 - a. Office of The Assistant Secretary of the Army.
 - b. Office, Assistant Secretary of the Army.
