- 2. Effective 31 December 1948, the Military Police School, a class II activity under the control of the Provost Marshal General, will be discontinued at Carlisle Barracks, Pennsylvania.

II_RETIRING BOARDS.—1. Army retiring boards appointed to convene at the following general hospitals will be dissolved effective 1 November 1948. The appointment of retiring boards to convene at these installations will no longer be authorized after that date, except as provided in paragraph 2.

Army and Navy General Hospital, Hot Springs, Arkansas.

Madigan General Hospital, Tacoma, Washington.

McCornack General Hospital, Pasadena, California.

Tilton General Hospital, Fort Dix, New Jersey.

William Beaumont General Hospital, El Paso, Texas.

2. The Department of the Army or the Department of the Air Force may, from time to time, direct the appropriate army or air force commander to convene a retiring board at any of the above-named hospitals when a retiring board is required for consideration of a particular case, and such consideration cannot be otherwise effected.
