**I. INSTALLATIONS.**—1. *Effective 30 June 1949*, the class II installations under the Chief of Transportation listed below are reclassified class I installations under the commanding general of the army indicated:

Fort Hamilton, New York.....	First.
Camp Kilmer, New Jersey.....	First.
Camp Leroy Johnson, Iowa.....	Fourth.
Camp Stoneman, California.....	Sixth.
Fort Lawton, Washington.....	Sixth.

2. *Effective 30 June 1949*, all personnel centers located at the above-named installations, as well as all activities required for the operation of the personnel centers, are also reclassified class I activities under the appropriate army commander.

**II.
