**III..ENGINEER SECTION, RICHMOND QUARTERMASTER DEPOT, VIRGINIA.**—*Effective as of 11 December 1949,* the Engineer Section of Richmond Quartermaster Depot, Virginia, was discontinued.

**IV..NEW ORLEANS PERSONNEL CENTER, NEW ORLEANS PORT OF EMBARKATION, LOUISIANA.**—*Effective 1 February 1950,* the New Orleans Personnel Center, New Orleans Port of Embarkation, Louisiana, will be discontinued.

**V..SECTION 55C, NATIONAL DEFENSE ACT, UNIT.**—*Effective at the end of the current academic year,* the military training unit at Brawley Union High School, Brawley, California, established under the provisions of section 55c, National Defense Act, will be withdrawn.
