I. ARMY WAR COLLEGE.—Effective as of 25 January 1950, the Army War College was reestablished as a class I activity and will be located temporarily at Fort Leavenworth, Kansas.

II. CRIMINAL INVESTIGATION LABORATORY.—Effective as of 1 January 1950, the Criminal Investigation Laboratory was established at Camp Gordon, Georgia, as a class II activity under the control of the Provost Marshal General.

III. DICKSON GUN PLANT, TEXAS.—Effective as of 31 January 1950, the Dickson Gun Plant, Texas, a subinstallation of Watervliet Arsenal, New York, was redesignated a subinstallation of San Jacinto Ordnance Depot, Texas, a class II installation under the jurisdiction of the Chief of Ordnance.

IV. NEW RIVER ORDNANCE PLANT, VIRGINIA.—Effective as of 31 January 1950, the New River Ordnance Plant, Virginia, was discontinued as a subpost and redesignated part of Radford Arsenal, Virginia, a class II industrial installation under the jurisdiction of the Chief of Ordnance.
