3. Physical examinations required for promotion.—All officers listed in paragraph 1 are required to take a physical examination in order to qualify for promotion as provided in C 7, AR 40-100. Reports of physical examination prepared on Standard Form 88 (Report of Medical Examination) will be forwarded to the Surgeon General, Department of the Army, Washington 25, D. C., Attention: MEDDP, as soon as completed, and in any event in time to reach that office not later than 15 April 1950. The forwarding communication will state specifically that the report is furnished in connection with promotion in the Regular Army.
