DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY
WASHINGTON 25, D. C., 11 April 1950

1. *Effective immediately*, DA General Orders 44, 1948, is rescinded.
2. The Assistant Secretary of the Army whose duties relate generally to the establishment of policies for, direction and supervision of activities concerned with procurement, industrial and related matters, including industrial mobilization and demobilization, and research and development, will be referred to as the Assistant Secretary of the Army (Matériel).
3. The Assistant Secretary of the Army whose duties relate generally to the direction and supervision of Comptroller functions under the provisions of title IV, Public Law 216—81st Congress, and the management improvement program pursuant to Executive Order 10072, 29 July 1949, will be referred to as the Assistant Secretary of the Army (General Management).
