**I. GENERAL COURTS MARTIAL.**—By direction of the President, the commanding officer, Pusan Base Command, and the commanding officer, United States Army Forces in Korea, are empowered, pursuant to the eighth article of war, to appoint general courts martial, *effective 6 July 1950.*

**II. ARMY OF OCCUPATION MEDAL WITH BERLIN AIRLIFT DEVICE.**—

1. So much of paragraph 2, section III, DA General Orders 21, 1949, as amended by section III, DA General Orders 33, 1949, section I, DA General Orders 44, 1949, and section III, DA General Orders 48, 1949, as reads "(date to be announced)" is amended to read "30 September 1949," except as follows:

2. The following units are designated as participating in the Berlin airlift for the periods indicated and, under AR 600-65/AFR 35-50, personnel assigned or attached thereto for a period of 90 consecutive days are entitled to the award of the Army of Occupation Medal with Berlin airlift device:

Units	Inclusive dates
26th Base Post Office-----	26 June 1948 to 30 September 1949.
7747th Military Police Railway Security Group.	26 June 1948 to 30 September 1949.
7772d Signal Battalion-----	26 June 1948 to 30 September 1949.
7772d Signal Service Company-----	10 January to 1 September 1949.
7811th Station Complement Unit, Companies A, B, C, and H.	26 June 1948 to 30 September 1949.

3. So much of paragraph 1, section I, DA General Orders 44, 1949, as designates the Transportation, Sub-Post Engineer, and Ordnance Sections, Frankfurt Military Post, as participating in the Berlin airlift from 26 June 1948 to April 1949 is rescinded.
