I. OFFICERS.—1. By direction of the President and the Secretary of Defense pursuant to the provisions of section 2 of the Selective Service Extension Act of 1950 (Public Law 509, 81st Cong.; sec. VI, DA Bul. 12, 1950), it is ordered that the tour of duty for all officers of the Army (other than Regular officers) who are serving on extended active duty for periods in excess of 90 days in the service of the United States under orders in which the date of expiration of such tour of duty is specifically stated therein or which may be established by reference to a service category, regulation, or other directive of the Department of the Army, pursuant to which such tour of duty would expire before 2400 hours, 8 July 1951, is hereby extended from the date of such expiration for a period of 21 consecutive months or such other period as may be authorized unless the officer concerned is sooner relieved from duty.

2. Officers may, not earlier than 8 months prior to the date upon which their present tour of duty would have expired except for this order, volunteer in writing to extend such present tour of duty for a period of not less than 21 months from the date of expiration of their present tour of duty in accordance with current regulations, provided they are eligible therefor.

3. No change in grade, assignment, or station is authorized by reason of this order. However, this order shall not be construed as preventing future promotions, assignments, reassignments, or changes of station as may be authorized by law or regulation.
