**I. GENERAL COURTS MARTIAL.**—By direction of the President, the commanding officer, Camp Stewart, Georgia, is empowered, pursuant to AW 8, to appoint general courts martial, effective 8 December 1950.

**II. GENERAL COURTS MARTIAL.**—1. By direction of the President, the commanding officer, 7126 AU, is empowered, pursuant to AW 8, to appoint general courts martial, effective 9 January 1951.

**III. OFFICE OF THE CHIEF OF PSYCHOLOGICAL WARFARE, SPECIAL STAFF, UNITED STATES ARMY.**—1. Announcement is made of the establishment, on 15 January 1951, of the Office of the Chief of Psychological Warfare, Special Staff, United States Army.

2. The Chief of Psychological Warfare formulates and develops psychological warfare plans for the Army in consonance with established policy and recommends policies for and supervises the execution of Department of the Army psychological warfare programs.
