I..ADJUTANT GENERAL'S SCHOOL.—1. *Effective 6 March 1951*, the Adjutant General's School is discontinued at Fort Lee, Virginia, and concurrently established at Fort Benjamin Harrison, Indiana, as a class II activity under the jurisdiction of The Adjutant General.
