GENERAL ORDERS No. 89 DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY WASHINGTON 25, D.C., 18 October 1951

- 1. By virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 101 (b), Army Organization Act of 1950, I hereby designate the Assistant Secretary of the Army (Manpower and Reserve Forces) to act for me in approving training programs involving payment of tuition as required by Section 610, Department of Defense Appropriation Act, 1952.
- 2. Installations, commands or services of the Army Establishment finding it necessary to execute contracts for training of civilian employees, which require payment of tuition to public or private institutions or plants, shall submit requests for approval of such training programs in accordance with instructions which shall be prescribed by the Director of Civilian Personnel, Office of the Secretary of the Army.
