- I..FORT RITCHIE, MARYLAND.—1. Effective 1 November 1951, the installation known as Camp Ritchie, Maryland, is established as a permanent Army installation and designated Fort Ritchie, Maryland.
- 2. Effective 1 November 1951, Fort Ritchie, Maryland, is established as a class I installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Second Army, and placed in an active status.

II..ARMY AND NAVY HOSPITAL, HOT SPRINGS, ARKANSAS.—Effective I November 1951, the Army and Navy General Hospital, located at Hot Springs, Arkansas, is redesignated the Army and Navy Hospital, a class II installation under the jurisdiction of The Surgeon General.

III...SAN FRANCISCO QUARTERMASTER CENTER, ALAMEDA, CALI-FORNIA.—1. Effective 15 October 1951, the San Francisco Quartermaster Market Center, Alameda, California, is established as a class II activity, under the jurisdiction of The Quartermaster General, at Alameda Medical Depot, California, a class II installation under the jurisdiction of The Surgeon General.

2. Effective 30 November 1951, the San Francisco Quartermaster Market Center, 180 New Montgomery Street, San Francisco, California, is discontinued.
