**I..CAMP SAN LUIS OBISPO, CALIFORNIA.**—1. *Effective 15 December 1951*, Camp San Luis Obispo, California, a class I installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Sixth Army, is redesignated a class II installation under the jurisdiction of the Chief Signal Officer.

2. *Effective 15 December 1951*, the Southwestern Signal Replacement Training Center is established as a class II activity, under the jurisdiction of the Chief Signal Officer, at Camp San Luis Obispo, California.

3. *Effective 15 December 1951*, the Southwestern Signal School is established as a class II activity, under the jurisdiction of the Chief Signal Officer, at Camp San Luis Obispo, California.

**II..MEDICAL REPLACEMENT TRAINING CENTERS.**—1. *Effective 15 November 1951*, the Medical Replacement Training Center is established as a class I activity at Camp Pickett, Virginia, a class I installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Second Army.

2. *Effective 15 February 1952*, the Medical Replacement Training Center, located at Fort Sam Houston, Texas, is discontinued.

3. *Effective 15 April 1952*, the Medical Replacement Training Center, located at Fort George G. Meade, Maryland, is discontinued.
