I..GENERAL COURTS MARTIAL.—The commanding officer, Fort George G. Meade, Maryland, is designated by the Secretary of the Army, pursuant to the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 22(a) (6), to convene general courts martial, *effective 15 November 1952.*

IV..FINANCE OFFICE, U. S. ARMY, PARIS, FRANCE.—1. *Effective 1 October 1952,* the Finance Office, U. S. Army, Paris, France, APO 58, c/o Postmaster, New York, New York, is discontinued as an activity under the control of the Chief of Finance and is transferred to the jurisdiction of the Commander-in-Chief, United States Army, Europe.

2. So much of paragraph 1, DA General Orders 27, 1952, as pertains to Finance Offices, U. S. Army, 284-294 West Peachtree Street, N. W., Atlanta, Georgia, and Paris, France, APO 58, c/o Postmaster, New York, New York, is rescinded.
