I.—ARMED FORCES MEDICAL LIBRARY, WASHINGTON, D. C.—The Army Medical Library, Washington 25, D. C., a class II activity under the control of The Surgeon General, Department of the Army, is redesignated the Armed Forces Medical Library, a joint agency of the three military departments, subject to the authority, direction, and control of the Secretary of Defense and under the management control of the Secretary of the Army. The management authority vested in the Secretary of the Army is delegated to The Surgeon General, Department of the Army. The Commanding General, Military District of Washington, is responsible for those functions at the Armed Forces Medical Library as provided in SR 10-500-1.
