I. GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL. The Commandant, Branch United States Disciplinary Barracks, New Cumberland, Pennsylvania, is designated by the Secretary of the Army, pursuant to the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 22 (a) (6), to convene general courts-martial, *effective 15 January 1953.*

II. CAMP MCCOY, WISCONSIN.—*Effective 1 February 1953,* Camp McCoy, Wisconsin, a class I installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Fifth Army, is placed in an inactive status.

III. FORT CAMPBELL, KENTUCKY.—*Effective 1 March 1953,* Fort Campbell, Kentucky, a class I installation, is transferred from the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Second Army, to the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Third Army. The location and post office address remain unchanged.

IV. BRANCH UNITED STATES DISCIPLINARY BARRACKS, CAMP CROWDER, MISSOURI.—*Effective 1 February 1953,* the Branch United States Disciplinary Barracks is established as a class I activity at Camp Crowder, Missouri, under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Fifth Army.

V. DA GENERAL ORDERS 12, 1953.—The date of DA General Orders 12, 1953 is changed from "22 January 1953" to "19 January 1953."

VI. ARMY OF OCCUPATION MEDAL WITH BERLIN AIRLIFT DEVICE.—
1. So much of paragraph 1, section I, DA General Orders 44, 1949, as amended by paragraph 1, section II, DA General Orders 22, 1950, as pertains to the 80th Transportation Truck Company (Heavy) for the period from 6 June 1949 to 30 September 1949 is further amended to read "6 April 1949 to 30 September 1949."

2. So much of paragraph 2, section II, DA General Orders 22, 1950, as pertains to Companies A, B, C, and H, 7811th Station Complement Unit for the period 26 June 1948 to 30 September 1949 is amended to add "Headquarters, 7811th Station Complement 26 June 1948 to 30 September 1949."
