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DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY RECEIVING STATION, LA PLATA, MARYLAND—War Department New Receiving Station redesignated; established as activity of Army Command and Administrative Communication Agency-----	II
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I..FORT NIAGARA, NEW YORK.—Effective 15 April 1953, Fort Niagara, New York, is established and activated as a class I installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, First Army.

2. Effective 1 April 1953, The Department of the Army Receiving Station, La Plata, Maryland, is established as an activity of the Army Command and Administrative Communication Agency, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Chief Signal Officer.
