**REPUBLIC OF KOREA PRESIDENTIAL UNIT CITATION** awarded by citation dated 7 July 1953, by Syngman Rhee, President of the Republic of Korea, for exceptionally meritorious service to the Republic of Korea during the period 2 July 1952 to 7 July 1953, inclusive, with citation as follows:

Headquarters and Headquarters Company, Eighth United States Army, rendered outstanding service to the Government of the Republic of Korea by superbly performing its vital mission. Perplexing problems were faced with unwavering self assurance and resolved with precision and dispatch, thereby earning for the officers and men a reputation for excellence in the performance of an exacting assignment.

The unselfish effort expended by Headquarters and Headquarters Company in aiding the expansion of the Republic of Korea Army helped its gallant troops immeasurably in preparing themselves to carry a larger share in the protection of their homeland from the Communist aggressors.

Though primarily concerned with military affairs, Headquarters and Headquarters Company never forgot the civilian populace. The impetus and support which they rendered in reconstruction projects vital to the welfare of the Korean people and their ceaseless effort to help provide basic essentials to refugees has earned for them the deepest
