DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY
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I. QM RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT CENTER, NATICK, MASSACHUSETTS.—Effective 1 October 1953, the Natick QM Research and Development Laboratory, Natick, Massachusetts, is redesignated the QM Research and Development Center, a class II installation under the jurisdiction of The Quartermaster General.

II. HEADQUARTERS, QM RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT COMMAND, NATICK, MASSACHUSETTS.—Effective 1 October 1953, Headquarters, QM Research and Development Command, is established at the QM Research and Development Center, Natick, Massachusetts, as a class II activity under the jurisdiction of The Quartermaster General. The Headquarters, QM Research and Development Command, will include command of the following separate class II activities:

a. QM Research and Development Laboratories at Jeffersonville QM Depot, Jeffersonville, Indiana.

b. QM Research and Development Laboratories at Philadelphia QM Depot, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

c. QM Food and Container Institute for the Armed Forces at Chicago QM Depot, Chicago, Illinois.

d. QM Board at Fort Lee, Virginia.

III. HUNTER LIGGETT MILITARY RESERVATION, CALIFORNIA.—Effective 1 October 1953, Hunter Liggett Military Reservation, California, is redesignated from a class I subinstallation of Camp Roberts, California, to a class I subinstallation of Fort Ord, California, a class I installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Sixth Army.

Ardennes-Alsace.—DA General Orders 63, 1948, as amended by paragraph 24, section I, DA General Orders 72, 1948; paragraph 2, section II, DA General Orders 6, 1950; paragraph 3, section I, DA General Orders 37, 1950; and paragraph 2, section III, DA General Orders 32, 1953, pertaining to the Ardennes-Alsace campaign, is further amended as follows:

* Add: 17th Replacement Depot.

* **2. Luzon.**—Section XVII, WD General Orders 12, 1946, as amended by paragraph 4, section V, DA General Orders 29, 1948; paragraph 18, section I, DA General Orders 72, 1948; paragraph 6, section II, DA General Orders 6, 1950; paragraph 7, section I, DA General Orders 37, 1950; paragraph 10, section III, DA General Orders 32, 1953; and paragraph 1, section VI, DA General Orders 47, 1953, pertaining to the Luzon campaign, is further amended as follows:

Add: 221st Airborne Medical Company.

* **3. Normandy.**—WD General Orders 102, 1945, as amended by paragraph 8, section I, DA General Orders 72, 1948; paragraph 9, section II, DA General Orders 6, 1950; paragraph 10, section I, DA General Orders 37, 1950; and paragraph 13, section III, DA General Orders 32, 1953, pertaining to the Normandy campaign, is further amended as follows:

Add: 101st Evacuation Hospital, Semimobile.

* **VI. UNITS CREDITED WITH ASSAULT LANDINGS.**—**1. Luzon.**—Paragraph 4, section II, WD General Orders 109, 1946, as amended by paragraph 2, section II, DA General Orders 23, 1947; paragraph 3, section II, DA General Orders 37, 1950; paragraph 2, section IV, DA General Orders 32, 1953; and section III, DA General Orders 50, 1953, pertaining to the Luzon assault landings is further amended as follows:

a. *Lingayen Gulf, Luzon, Philippine Islands.*

Add: 40th Reconnaissance Troop, Mechanized.

* **2. Northern Solomons.**—Paragraph 6, section II, WD General Orders 109, 1946, pertaining to the Northern Solomons assault landings is amended as follows:

k. *Treasury Island.*

Delete: 198th Coast Artillery Antiaircraft Battalion (less detachments).

Add: 198th Coast Artillery Regiment (Antiaircraft).
