I. ARMY AND NAVY HOSPITAL, HOT SPRINGS, ARKANSAS.—Effective 28 February 1954, the Army and Naval Hospital, Hot Springs, Arkansas, a class II installation under the jurisdiction of The Surgeon General, is placed in an inactive status.

II. CAMP SAN LUIS OBISPO, CALIFORNIA.—1. Effective 15 November 1953, Camp San Luis Obispo, California, a class II installation under the jurisdiction of the Chief Signal Officer, is redesignated a class I installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Sixth Army, and placed in an inactive status.

2. Section V, DA General Orders 56, 1953, is rescinded.

SIGNAL CORPS REPLACEMENT TRAINING CENTER, CAMP GORDON, GEORGIA.—Effective 1 November 1953, the Signal Corps Replacement Training Center is discontinued as a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Chief Signal Officer, located at Camp Gordon, Georgia, a class I installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Third Army.

IV. MILITARY POLICE REPLACEMENT TRAINING CENTER, CAMP GORDON, GEORGIA.—Effective 1 November 1953, the Military Police Replacement Training Center is discontinued as a class II activity under the jurisdiction of The Provost Marshal General, located at Camp Gordon, Georgia, a class I installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Third Army.

V. CAMP GORDON REPLACEMENT TRAINING CENTER, CAMP GORDON, GEORGIA.—Effective 1 November 1953, the Camp Gordon Replacement Training Center is established as a class I activity at Camp Gordon, Georgia, a class I installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Third Army.
