FUNCTIONS OF THE UNDER SECRETARY AND ASSISTANT SECRETARIES OF THE ARMY

- 1. The Office of the Under Secretary of the Army is redesignated the Office of the Assistant Secretary of the Army (Financial Management). All authority, powers, and duties heretofore assigned to the Under Secretary of the Army are hereby assigned to the Assistant Secretary of the Army (Financial Management), with the exception of those set forth in the first two sentences of paragraph 2, DA General Orders 23, 1953.
- 2. The Office of the Assistant Secretary of the Army (Materiel) is redesignated the Office of the Under Secretary of the Army. All authority, powers, and duties heretofore assigned to the Assistant Secretary of the Army (Materiel) are hereby assigned to the Under Secretary of the Army.
- 3. The position of Deputy Under Secretary of the Army is redesignated Deputy Assistant Secretary of the Army (Financial Management).
- 4. The position of Deputy Assistant Secretary of the Army (Materiel) is redesignated Deputy Under Secretary of the Army.
- 5. The authority, powers, and duties assigned to the Assistant Secretary of the Army (Manpower and Reserve Forces) shall not be affected by this general order.
 - 6. The effective date of this order is 8 February 1954.
