I..ALABAMA ORDNANCE WORKS, CHILDERSBURG, ALABAMA.—So much of section I, General Orders 9, 1954, as reads "Childersburg, Alabama," is changed to read "Childersburg, Alabama."

II..ARMY MAP SERVICE, WASHINGTON, D. C.—Effective 1 January 1954, the Army Map Service, Washington, D. C., a class II industrial installation under the jurisdiction of the Chief of Engineers, is redesignated a class II command installation under the jurisdiction of the Chief of Engineers.

III..ENGINEER RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT LABORATORIES, FORT BELVOIR, VIRGINIA.—Effective 1 January 1954, the Engineer Research and Development Laboratories, a class II industrial activity, is redesignated a class II command activity at Fort Belvoir, Virginia, a class II command installation under the jurisdiction of the Chief of Engineers.

IV..MEDICAL TRAINING CENTER, FORT SAM HOUSTON, TEXAS.—Effective 1 March 1954, the Medical Training Center is established as an activity of the Brooke Army Medical Center, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of The Surgeon General, at Fort Sam Houston, Texas.

V..MEDICAL REPLACEMENT TRAINING CENTER, CAMP PICKETT, VIRGINIA.—Effective 22 May 1954, the Medical Replacement Training Center, a class I activity at Camp Pickett, Virginia, is discontinued.

VI..ORDNANCE REPLACEMENT TRAINING CENTER, ABERDEEN PROVING GROUND, MARYLAND.—Effective 22 May 1954, the Ordnance Replacement Training Center, Aberdeen Proving Ground, Maryland, an activity of the Ordnance Training Command, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Chief of Ordnance, is discontinued.

VII. OFFICE OF ARMY REPRESENTATIVE TO INTER-AMERICAN BOARDS, 8549AAU.--Effective 1 February 1954, the Office of Army Representative to Inter-American Boards, 8549AAU, is established as an Army General and Special Staff Area unit.

VIII. PERSONNEL PROCESSING ACTIVITIES.--Paragraph 2, section VII, General Orders 77, 1953, as amended by section IV, General Orders 87, 1953, is further amended as follows:

1. Effective 10 March 1954, the reception stations of the personnel centers at Fort George G. Meade, Maryland, and Fort Riley, Kansas, are discontinued.

2. Effective 1 March 1954, the following personnel center, with attendant activities, is established:
