**I. BRANCH UNITED STATES DISCIPLINARY BARRACKS, LOMPOC, CALIFORNIA.**—Effective 15 September 1954, the Branch U. S. Disciplinary Barracks, Lompoc, California, a class I activity of Camp Cooke, California, is redesignated a class I installation, under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Sixth Army.

**II. CAMP STEWART AAA AND TANK TRAINING CENTER, CAMP STEWART, GEORGIA.**—1. Effective 1 October 1954, the Camp Stewart AAA and Tank Training Center is established as a class I activity at Camp Stewart, Georgia, a class I installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Third Army.

2. Section IV, DA General Orders 57, 1954, is rescinded.

**III. QUARTERMASTER RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT CENTER, MASSACHUSETTS.**—Effective 20 September 1954, the Quartermaster Research and Development Center, Massachusetts, is announced as a permanent Department of the Army installation.

**IV. SCHOFIELD BARRACKS, OAHU, TERRITORY OF HAWAII.**—Effective 20 September 1954, the Armed Forces Examining Station, Tripler Army Hospital, Oahu, Territory of Hawaii, established by section I, DA General Orders 82, 1951, is redesignated Schofield Barracks, Oahu, Territory of Hawaii.

**V. SHARPE GENERAL DEPOT, U. S. ARMY, CALIFORNIA.**—Effective 1 January 1955, a Medical Section is established as a class II activity, under the jurisdiction of The Surgeon General, at Sharpe General Depot, U. S. Army, California, a class II installation, under the jurisdiction of The Quartermaster General.

**VI. TRANSPORTATION CORPS MOVEMENT CONTROL OFFICE, REDSTONE ARSENAL, ALABAMA.**—Effective 1 October 1954, a Transportation Corps Movement Control Office is established as a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Chief of Transportation, at Redstone Arsenal, Alabama, a class II installation under the jurisdiction of the Chief of Ordnance.
