I..GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL. The Commanding Officer, The Artillery and Guided Missile Center, Fort Sill, Oklahoma, is designated by the Secretary of the Army, pursuant to the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 22(a) (6) to convene general courts-martial, *effective 13 April 1955.*

II..DESERET CHEMICAL DEPOT, UTAH. *Effective 1 May 1955,* the Deseret Chemical Depot, Utah, a class II installation under the jurisdiction of the Chief Chemical Officer is redesignated Deseret Depot Activity, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Chief of Ordnance.

III..DESERET DEPOT ACTIVITY, UTAH. *Effective 1 May 1955,* the Deseret Depot Activity, Utah, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Chief of Ordnance, is designated as an activity of the Tooele Ordnance Depot, Utah, a class II installation under the jurisdiction of the Chief Ordnance.

IV..CONVERSION TO GENERAL MILITARY SCIENCE CURRICULUM.

1. Effective the beginning of the 1955-56 academic year, the following branch type ROTC units are converted to General Military Science ROTC units:
