I. ARMY GENERAL SCHOOL, FORT RILEY, KANSAS. Subparagraphs *b* and *d*, section II, General Orders 20, 1955, are amended to read as follows:

b. The Department of Extension Courses less the Military Intelligence Branch, the National Guard State OCS, and the Physical Training Department to Commandant, Infantry School, Fort Benning, Georgia. The date of reassignment and movement of these elements will be at the discretion of the Commanding General, Continental Army Command.

d. The Aggressor Cadre and Sonic Effects Platoon to the Commanding General, Fifth Army. These elements will remain stationed at Fort Riley, Kansas. [AG 352 (12 May 55)].

II. FINANCE OFFICE, U. S. ARMY, OAKLAND, CALIFORNIA. 1. *Effective 1 June 1955*, the Finance Office, U. S. Army, Oakland, California, a class II activity under the Chief of Finance, is discontinued and its functions assigned to the Chief of Ordnance.

2. The continuance of finance services now furnished to class II installations and activities by the Finance Office, U. S. Army, Oakland, California, will be the responsibility of the Chief of Ordnance, until other arrangements are authorized by the Department of the Army.
