I...ARMY SIGNAL CORPS COMMUNICATIONS SECURITY SERVICE, ARLINGTON HALL STATION, VIRGINIA. Effective 20 October 1955, the Army Signal Corps Communications Security Service is established as a class II activity, under the jurisdiction of the Chief Signal Officer, at Arlington Hall Station, Virginia.

II...TULALIP BACK-UP STORAGE AREA, WASHINGTON. Effective 1 November 1955, the Tulalip Back-Up Storage Area, Washington, a class I sub-Installation of Fort Lewis, Washington, is redesignated as a class I subinstallation of Fort Lawton, Washington, a class I installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Sixth Army.

III..TECHNICAL LIAISON GROUP (SIGNAL CORPS ENGINEERING LABORATORIES) McCORNACK ARMY HOSPITAL, PASADENA, CALIFORNIA. Effective 15 October 1955, the Technical Liaison Group (Signal Corps Engineering Laboratories), a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Chief Signal Officer, located at McCornack Army Hospital, Pasadena, California, is discontinued.
