**I..DEPUTY CHIEF OF STAFF FOR PERSONNEL.** 1. *Effective 3 January 1956*, the Office of the Deputy Chief of Staff for Operations and Administration is redesignated Office of the Deputy Chief of Staff for Personnel.

2. Effective the same date, the Office of the Assistant Chief of Staff, G-1, is abolished and all functions transferred to the Office of the Deputy Chief of Staff for Personnel.

**II..DEPUTY CHIEF OF STAFF FOR MILITARY OPERATIONS.** 1. *Effective 3 January 1956*, the Office of the Deputy Chief of Staff for Plans is redesignated Office of the Deputy Chief of Staff for Military Operations.

2. Effective the same date, the Office of the Assistant Chief of Staff, G-3, is abolished and all functions transferred to the Office of the Deputy Chief of Staff for Military Operations.

**III..ASSISTANT CHIEF OF STAFF, G-2, INTELLIGENCE.** *Effective 3 January 1956*, the Assistant Chief of Staff, G-2, Intelligence, is redesignated Assistant Chief of Staff, Intelligence.
