IV..CAMP CHAFFEE, ARKANSAS. *Effective 21 March 1956*, Camp Chaffee, Arkansas, is redesignated Fort Chaffee, Arkansas, and announced as a permanent Department of the Army installation.

V..CAMP STEWART, GEORGIA. *Effective 21 March 1956*, Camp Stewart, Georgia, is redesignated Fort Stewart, Georgia, and announced as a permanent Department of the Army installation.
