I..LORDSTOWN MILITARY RESERVATION, OHIO. *Effective 1 July 1956,* Lordstown Military Reservation, Ohio, is established and designated a class I installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Second Army, and placed in an active status.

II..LORDSTOWN ORDNANCE DEPOT. *Effective 1 July 1956,* the Lordstown Ordnance Depot, a class II installation under the jurisdiction of the Chief of Ordnance, is redesignated the Lordstown Storage Activity, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Chief of Ordnance, at Lordstown Military Reservation, Ohio, a class I installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Second Army.

III..CLEVELAND ORDNANCE DISTRICT INDUSTRIAL STORAGE ACTIVITY, WARREN, OHIO. *Effective 1 July 1956,* the Cleveland Ordnance District Industrial Storage Activity, Warren, Ohio, is established as a class II industrial activity under the jurisdiction of the Chief of Ordnance, at Lordstown Military Reservation, Ohio, a class I installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Second Army.

IV..SOUTH PARK MILITARY RESERVATION, PENNSYLVANIA. *Effective 1 July 1956,* South Park Military Reservation, Pennsylvania, is redesignated a class I subinstallation of Lordstown Military Reservation, Ohio, a class I installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Second Army, and placed in an active status.
