## ASSISTANT CHIEF OF STAFF FOR RESERVE COMPONENTS

- 1. Effective 1 November 1956, the Office of the Assistant Chief of Staff for Reserve Components is established in the Army Staff.
- 2. Effective the same date, the following organizational elements are abolished and all of their assigned functions are transferred to the Office of the Assistant Chief of Staff for Reserve Components:
- a. Office of the Special Assistant to the Chief of Staff for Reserve Components, Office of the Chief of Staff.
- b. Reserve Components Division of the Office of the Director, Organization and Training, Office of the Deputy Chief of Staff for Military Operations.
- c. Reserve Components Division of the Office of the Deputy Chief of Staff for Personnel.
