II.—ARMY MEDICAL OPTICAL ACTIVITY, ST. LOUIS, MISSOURI. *Effective 1 January 1957*, the Army Medical Optical Activity, St. Louis, Missouri, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of The Surgeon General, is redesignated the U. S. Army Medical Optical and Maintenance Activity.
