For the purpose of this directive, the agency designation of the National Guard Bureau and the Office of the Director of Armed Forces Information and Education, Department of Defense, will be changed only so far as pertains to the elimination of the numerical suffix as part of the agency designation. However, for the purpose of TD designation of the Army portion of these agencies, the designations become National Guard Bureau, United States Army Element and United States Army Element, Office of the Director of Armed Forces Information and Education, Department of Defense.

3. For administrative purposes each table of distribution will continue to utilize the currently assigned number. However, this number will be utilized only for the purpose of additional identification in certain administrative actions such as General Orders and organizational reports prepared for and by the Department of the Army. In those administrative actions which require reference to the unit number for additional identification, such reference will be made by inclusion of the TD base number following the unit designation. The unit number will not be used in unit signs, letterheads and similar references.

4. When "Department of the Army" is used as an integral part of agency signs, letterheads, and similar references, the "U. S. Army" suffix to an agency designation will be omitted from the designation; when "U. S." or "United States" appears within the designation of an agency, it will remain as an integral part of the designation. Existing stocks of letterheads, forms, etc., bearing current designations will be continued in use until supplies are exhausted.
