I..UNITED STATES ARMY AVIATION SAFETY BOARD, FORT RUCKER, ALABAMA. *Effective 1 May 1957*, the United States Army Aviation Safety Board is established as a class II activity, under the jurisdiction of the Deputy Chief of Staff for Military Operations, at Fort Rucker, Alabama, a class I installation under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Third United States Army.
