I.—U. S. ARMY MIDDLE EAST SIGNAL COMMUNICATIONS DETACHMENT, APO 843, NEW YORK, NEW YORK. *Effective 1 July 1957*, the U. S. Army Middle East Signal Communications Detachment, APO 843, New York, New York, is redesignated as the U. S. Army Middle East Signal Communications Agency.
