**III. U. S. ARMY TRANSPORTATION CORPS MILITARY MOTOR TRANSPORT MANAGEMENT AGENCY.** Effective 1 December 1958, the U. S. Army Transportation Corps Military Motor Transport Management Agency, a class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Chief of Transportation, is redesignated as the U. S. Army Transportation Administrative Transport Management Agency.
