## HEADQUARTERS, DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY WASHINGTON 25, D.C., 20 February 1959

I...UNITED STATES ARMY ATOMIC ACCIDENT INVESTIGATION BOARD. Effective 19 January 1959, the United States Army Atomic Accident Investigation Board is established as a standing Investigation Board to investigate an atomic incident in order to ascertain its cause in accordance with the provisions of the United States Continental Army Basic Plan (U). The Board convenes upon notification that an atomic incident within the purview of the United States Continental Army Basic Plan has occurred. The Board reports the results of investigation to the Deputy Chief of Staff for Personnel, Department of the Army, Washington 25, D.C.

II\_ARMED FORCES EXAMINING STATION, OMAHA, NEBRASKA. Effective 1 March 1959, the Armed Forces Examining Station at Omaha, Nebraska, is discontinued as an element of the U.S. Navy Recruiting Main Station and designated an element of the U.S. Army Recruiting Main Station.

IV.\_LIMA ORDNANCE MODIFICATION CENTER, OHIO. Effective 31 March 1959, the Lima Ordnance Modification Center, Ohio, a class 11 industrial installation under the jurisdiction of the Chief of Ordnance, is placed in an inactive status.

V.LIMA DEPOT ACTIVITY, OHIO. Effective 31 March 1959, the Lima Depot Activity, Ohio, a class II storage activity under the jurisdiction of the Chief of Ordnance and located at the Lima Ordnance Modification Center, Ohio, is discontinued.

VI. JACK YATES SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL, HOUSTON, TEXAS. Effective 2 September 1958, Jack Yates Senior High School, Houston, Texas, in the Houston Independent School District, is authorized under title 10, United States Code, sections 3540b and 4651 to participate in the military training program, as a National Cadet Corps School, in the National Defense Cadet Corps Program.
