I..GENERAL COURTS-MARTIAL. The Commanding Officer, United States Army Japan and 6th Logistical Command (C), is designated by the Secretary of the Army, pursuant to the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 22(a) (6), to convene general courts-martial, *effective 1 July 1959.*

II..ARMY AND NAVY HOSPITAL, ARKANSAS. *Effective 1 December 1959,* the Army and Navy Hospital, Arkansas, a class II installation under the jurisdiction of The Surgeon General, is placed in an inactive status.

III..QUARTERMASTER SUBSISTENCE SCHOOL, FORT LEE, VIRGINIA.

1. *Effective 1 October 1959,* the Quartermaster Subsistence School, a class II activity under the control of The Quartermaster General and under the jurisdiction of the Commanding General, Quartermaster Training Command, is discontinued. The facilities and activities comprising the Quartermaster Subsistence School are consolidated with and made a part of the Quartermaster School, Quartermaster Training Command, Fort Lee, Virginia.

2. Section II, DA General Orders 67, 1948, and Section II DA General Orders 5, 1959, are rescinded.

IV..U.S. ARMY ELEMENT, PANAMA CANAL ZONE GOVERNMENT (8730), BALBOA HEIGHTS, CANAL ZONE. *Effective 2 November 1959,* the U.S. Army Element, Panama Canal Zone Government (8730), is redesignated the U.S. Army Element, Canal Zone Government (8730).

V..BOOKER T. WASHINGTON HIGH SCHOOL, SHREVEPORT, LOUISIANA. *Effective 9 September 1959,* Booker T. Washington High School, Shreveport, Louisiana, is authorized under title 10, United States Code, sections 3540b and 4651, to participate in the military training program, as a National Defense Cadet Corps School, in the National Defense Cadet Corps Program.
