IV .. MILITARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT AGENCY. Effective 1 August 1960, so much of General Orders 2, 1957, as pertains to the boundaries of traffic regions of the Military Management Traffic Agency is amended as follows:

1. The Eastern Traffic Region will consist of the States of Connecticut, Delaware, Kentucky (less Fort Campbell), Maine, Maryland, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, Vermont, Virginia, West Virginia, and the District of Columbia.

2. The Southeastern Traffic Region will consist of the States of Alabama,

Florida, Georgia, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, Tennessee, and Fort Campbell, Kentucky.

3. The Central Traffic Region will consist of the States of Colorado, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota, South Dakota, Wisconsin, and Wyoming.

4. The Southwestern Trafile Region will consist of the States of Arkansas, Louislana, New Mexico, Oklahoma, and Texas.

5. The Western Traffic Region will consist of the States of Arizona, California, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, Oregon, Utah, and Washington.
