**I..UNITED STATES ARMY MISSION TO IRAN.** *Effective 1 October 1960,* the United States Army Mission to Iran (ARMISH) is relieved from direct control of Headquarters, Department of the Army, and assigned to Commander-in-Chief, United States European Command.

**II..UNITED STATES ARMY RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT MANPOWER SURVEY OFFICE (9844), WASHINGTON, D.C.** *Effective 8 September 1960,* the United States Army Research and Development Manpower Survey Office (9844) is organized with station in Washington, D.C., as a class II field activity under the command of the Chief of Research and Development.
